Assemblymember Maienschein Announces Increased Funding for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities

SACRAMENTO - Assemblymember Brian Maienschein, San Diego, today released the following statement about the enactment of legislation to increase funding for services to help individuals with developmental disabilities:

“Improving the conditions for this population has long been a priority for me. For years, a majority in Sacramento refused to fund programs for our state’s most vulnerable population.

“Since taking office in 2012, I have worked hand-in-hand with the developmental disability community, carried legislation and supported an increase in funding through the annual budget process. Finally, as a result of my continued efforts and with the help of several of my colleagues, the developmental disability community will receive more than \$300 million in state revenues for essential programs. This additional funding is great news for the community and will make a difference by helping more than 270,000 Californians live independent and fulfilling lives.”
